...1. Non-weight Bearing For 2 Weeks, Brace Locked In Extension 2. TTWB - 25% At 2 Weeks, Brace Locked In Extension 3. PWB 25-50% At 5-6 Weeks, Brace Locked In Extension 4. WBAT At 7 Weeks, Gradually Unlock And Wean From Brace ROM Guidelines 1. No Knee Flexion  $>90^{\circ}$  For 6 Weeks 2. No Active Mar 3th, 2024.

**Knee Ligament Injuries Early Treatment And ROM**

Active Range Of Motion. Knee Extension Is The Most Common Of The Motions That Is Lost, But Knee Flexion Can Become Difficult Due To Swelling. Quadriceps Strength Decreases Significantly Early And Needs To Be Re-enforced Through Isometric Exercise. Don't Be Fooled By The Large Amount Or Lack Of Sw
