Jaundice Is The Most Common Morbidity In The First Week Of Life, Occurring In 60% Of Term And 80% Of Preterm Newborn. Jaundice Is The Most Common Cause Of Readmission After Discharge From Birth Hospitalization.¹ Jaundice In Neonates Is Visible In Skin And Eyes When Total Serum Bilirubin (TSB) Concentration Exceeds 5 To 7 Mg/dL. 16th, 2024

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
